The Swan Creek Intercounty Drain Drainage Board will meet at the above date, time and location to consider the petition, received November 28, 2016, for maintenance and improvement and consolidating with the Jo Intercounty Drain, of an intercounty drain located in Saginaw County - Richland, Jonesfield, Thomas, Tittabawassee, Swan Creek, Lakefield, Fremont, and James Townships and the Village of Merrill; in Midland County - Ingersoll and Mt. Haley Townships; and in Gratiot County - Wheeler Township, pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, to determine the sufficiency of said petition, to go over the route of the intercounty drain and to further determine whether the maintenance and improvement of the intercounty drain is practicable.

Proceedings conducted at this public meeting will be subject to the provisions of the Michigan Open Meetings Act. Public comment will be received at the meeting from anyone owning lands liable to an assessment, or whose lands will be crossed by the drain, or any municipality affected.
