NOTICE OF MEETING OF BOARD OF DETERMINATION


Notice Is Hereby Given to you as a person owning lands liable for an assessment or a public corporation subject to assessment, that the Board of Determination will meet on **Thursday, May 21, 2015** at **7:00 p.m.** at the Saginaw Township Fire Station #1 located at **6171 Shattuck Rd., Saginaw, Michigan**, to hear all interested persons and evidence and to determine whether the petition for the cleaning out, relocating, widening, deepening, straightening, tiling, enlarging of tile size, extending, or relocating along a highway and or adding one or more branches of the drain known and designated as the Seidel Drain, located and established in the Charter Township of Saginaw, County of Saginaw, dated August 25, 2014, is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare; whether said drain is necessary for the protection of the public health of the following municipality: Saginaw Charter Township.

A presentation will be made **Thursday, May 21, 2015** to the Board of Determination which outlines a brief history of the Drainage District, and describes the roles, responsibilities and decisions made by a Board of Determination. The presentation is to provide background for landowners and municipalities in the drainage district and to facilitate the dissemination of information and the receipt of testimony of landowners in the Drainage District. A decision will be made by the Board of Determination after testimony is received.

Proceedings conducted at this public hearing will be subject to the provisions of the Michigan Open Meetings Act and you are further notified that information regarding this meeting may be obtained from the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioners Office located at 111 South Michigan Avenue, Saginaw, Michigan 48602. You Are Further Notified, that persons aggrieved by the decisions of the Board of Determination may seek judicial review in the Circuit Court for the County of Saginaw within ten (10) days of the determination.
