

**NOTICE OF LETTING OF DRAIN CONTRACT,
DAY OF REVIEW OF DRAINAGE DISTRICT REVISIONS
AND DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENTS**

SOUTHFIELD VILLAGE RELIEF DRAIN

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN, That I, Brian J. Wendling, Public Works Commissioner of the County of Saginaw, State of Michigan, will, on the **26th day of January, 2016**, at the office of the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner, 111 S. Michigan Avenue, Saginaw, Michigan 48602, receive construction bids until 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon of that day, when bids will be opened and publicly announced for the construction of a certain drain known and designated as SOUTHFIELD VILLAGE RELIEF DRAIN located and established in the Township Bridgeport in said County.

Said Drain is a tile drain approximately 4,600 feet in length with an average depth of 5½ feet and an outlet size of 24 inches. All stations are 100 feet apart. This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications, and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the contract. The following items will be required and a contract let for same:

Each proposal shall be accompanied by certified check or bidder's bond in the amount of 5% of the bid. Checks shall be drawn payable to the **Southfield Village Relief Drain Drainage District** as security for the acceptance of the Contract and subject to the conditions stated in the Instructions to Bidders. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in any bid, to reject any or all bids, or to accept any bid which is considered most favorable to the Owner.

A **mandatory pre-bid conference** will be held at 10:00 am on **12th day of January, 2016**, at the office of the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner, 111 S. Michigan Avenue, Saginaw, Michigan 48602. It is a requirement that any prospective General Contractor bidding attend this meeting. Representatives of the Owner and Professional will be present to discuss the project. Attendance is required for sealed bids to be accepted. The Professional will transmit to all prospective bidders of record an Addendum as the Professional considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be legally effective.

Hard copy proposal forms and specifications may be obtained by qualified bidders on **12th day January, 2016** at the mandatory pre-bid meeting for a \$25 fee, or at no charge at the website of the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner, <http://www.saginawcounty.com/PublicWorks/Current-Projects.aspx> beginning on the **4th day of January, 2016**. Please call Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner's office at 989-790-5258 to reserve a hard copy of the proposal forms and specifications by 8th day of January. **The Project is to be substantially completed by August 15, 2016 and ready for final payment by September 30, 2016.**

Said job will be let in accordance with the diagram now on file with the other papers pertaining to said Drain, in the office of the Public Works Commissioner of the County of Saginaw, to which reference may be had by all parties interested and bids will be made and received accordingly.

Contracts will be made with the lowest responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work, in the sum then and there to be fixed by me, reserving to myself the right to reject any and all bids, and to adjourn such letting to such time and place as I shall publicly announce.

The date for the completion of such contract, and the terms of payment therefore, shall and will be announced at the time and place of letting. Any person desiring to bid on the above-mentioned work will be required to deposit as a guarantee that he will enter into contract and furnish the required bond as prescribed by law. The checks of all unsuccessful bidders will be returned after contracts are awarded. The payments for the above-mentioned work will be made as follows:

Not later than the 25th day of each calendar month, the Owner will make partial payment to the Contractor on the basis of a duly certified, approved estimate of the work performed during the preceding calendar month by the Contractor, but the Owner will retain a percentage as stated in Act No. 524 of the amount of each such estimate until final completion and acceptance of all work covered by this contract.

Final Payment. Upon final completion and acceptance of the Work in accordance with paragraph 14.13 of the General Conditions, OWNER shall pay the remainder of the Contract Price as recommended by PROFESSIONAL as provided in Section 14.13.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT on, **12th day of January, 2016**, in the Office of the Public Works Commissioner, 111 S. Michigan Ave, Suite 103 Saginaw, Michigan; there will be a Day of Review Drainage District Revisions for the Southfield Village Relief Drain Drainage District.

The revision of drainage district boundaries by the addition and/or deletion of lands in the drainage district as recommended by a licensed professional engineer, will be available to review for one day, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. A general description of the lands by section number proposed to be added or deleted from the Drainage District as recommended by a licensed professional engineer or surveyor is as follows:

NOTICE IS FURTHER HEREBY GIVEN, that on the **16th day of February, 2016**, at the office of the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner, 111 S. Michigan Avenue, Saginaw, Michigan 48602, in the City of Saginaw, County of Saginaw, or at such other time and place thereafter, to which I, the Public Works Commissioner aforesaid, may adjourn the same, the apportionment for benefits and the lands comprised within the “Southfield Village Relief Drain Special Assessment District,” and the apportionments thereof will be subject to review for one day, from 9:00 o’clock in the forenoon until 5:00 o’clock in the afternoon. At said review, the computation of costs for said Drain will also be open for inspection by any parties interested. Drain assessments against land will be collected in the same manner as property taxes. If the collection period is greater than one year, the land owner may pay the assessments in full with any interest to date at any time and thereby avoid further interest charges.

The owner of any land in the special assessment district or any city, village, township, district or county who may disagree with the decisions of the Public Works Commissioner may appeal as follows: a) For decisions relating to the revisions of drainage district boundaries, to the Saginaw County Circuit Court pursuant to MCL 280.197; and/or b) For decisions relating to the apportionment of benefits by making an application to the Saginaw County Probate Court for appointment of a Board of Review, as provided in MCL 280.155. All appeals must be filed within 10 days of each determination.

The following is a condensed description of the land constituting the Southfield Village Relief Drain Drainage District as revised. The description of area that is served by the Southfield Village Relief Drain consists of lands situated in Sections 8 and 9 of Bridgeport Charter Township, T.11N.-R.05E., Saginaw County, Michigan.


