**There is a \$10 fee per student payable by cash or check to:
Saginaw County Sheriff Support Services.**

State law requires that anyone born on or after January 1, 1979 have a Boater Safety Certificate to operate a Personal Watercraft.

State law also requires anyone born on or after July 1, 1996 have a Boater safety Certificate to operate a boat.

Personal Water Craft may not be operated by an individual born after December 31, 1978 unless they have received a Boating Safety Certificate.

Upon successful completion of the course students will receive a Boating Safety Certificate. **There is a \$10 fee for the class payable by cash or check.** Parents and other adults may attend the classes.
