

## **NOTICE OF LETTING OF DRAIN CONTRACT AND DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENTS WOLF CREEK DRAIN**

**NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN**, That I, Brian J. Wendling, Public Works Commissioner of the County of Saginaw, State of Michigan, will, on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015, at the office of the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner, 111 S. Michigan Ave., Saginaw, Michigan 48602, receive construction bids until 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon of that day, when bids will be opened and publicly announced for the construction of a certain drain known and designated as WOLF CREEK DRAIN located and established in the Townships of Fremont and Swan Creek in said County.

Said Drain is an open channel approximately 14 miles in length. Said open drain to have a minimum 4-foot wide bottom width, with 2 horizontal to 1 vertical side slopes, and an average depth of 6 feet. All stations are 100 feet apart. Each proposal shall be accompanied by certified check or bidder's bond in the amount of 5% of the bid. Checks shall be drawn payable to the Wolf Creek Drain Drainage District (the "Drainage District") as security for the acceptance of the Contract and subject to the conditions stated in the Instructions to Bidders. The Drainage District reserves the right to waive informality in any bid, to reject any or all bids, or to accept any bid which is considered most favorable to the Drainage District.

Proposal forms and specifications may be obtained, at no charge, by qualified bidders at the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner's website at <http://www.saginawcounty.com/PublicWorks/Current-Projects.aspx> beginning on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015. Project to be substantially completed by August 31, 2016.

Said job will be let in accordance with the diagram now on file with the other papers pertaining to said Drain, in the office of the Public Works Commissioner of the County of Saginaw, to which reference may be had by all parties interested and bids will be made an received accordingly.

Contracts will be made with the lowest responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work, in the sum then and there to be fixed by me, reserving to myself the right to reject any and all bids, and to adjourn such letting to such time and place as I shall publicly announce.

The date for the completion of such contract, and the terms of payment therefore, shall and will be announced at the time and place of letting. Any person desiring to bid on the above-mentioned work will be required to deposit as a guarantee that they will enter into contract and furnish the required bonds as prescribed by law. The checks and other bid guarantees of all unsuccessful bidders will be returned after the contract is awarded. The payments for the above-mentioned work will be made as follows, as provided in the contract to be entered into with the successful bidder:

Not later than the 25th day of each calendar month, the Owner will make partial payment to the Contractor on the basis of a duly certified, approved estimate of the work performed during the preceding calendar month

by the Contractor, but the Owner will retain a percentage as stated in Act No. 524 of the amount of each such estimate until final completion and acceptance of all work covered by this contract.

*Final Payment.* Upon final completion and acceptance of the Work in accordance with paragraph 43 of the General Conditions, OWNER shall pay the remainder of the Contract Price as recommended by PROFESSIONAL as provided in Section 43.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER HEREBY GIVEN**, that on the **8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2015**, at the office of the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner, 111 S. Michigan Ave., Saginaw, Michigan 48602, in the City of Saginaw, County of Saginaw, or at such other time and place thereafter, to which I, the Public Works Commissioner aforesaid, may adjourn the same, the apportionment for benefits of the lands comprised within the “Wolf Creek Drain Special Assessment District,” and the apportionments thereof will be subject to review for one day, from 9:00 o’clock in the forenoon until 5:00 o’clock in the afternoon. At said review, the computation of costs for said Drain will also be open for inspection by any parties interested. Drain assessments against land will be collected in the same manner as property taxes. If the collection period is greater than one year, the land owner may pay the assessments in full with any interest to date at any time and thereby avoid further interest charges.

The following is a condensed description of the land constituting the Wolf Creek Drain Drainage District as revised. 
