



**NOTICE OF REGISTRATION
FOR THE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024
To the Qualified Electors of Saginaw County**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Saginaw County who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township or City Clerk; the Office of the appropriate County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. **Michigan residents with a valid Michigan driver's license or State ID can register online using the Michigan Online Voter Registration System at <https://mVIC.sos.state.mi.us/>** Registration forms can also be obtained at <https://mVIC.sos.state.mi.us/> and mailed to the Township or City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at <https://mVIC.sos.state.mi.us/>.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is Monday, October 21, 2024.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at their respective Township or City Clerk's office (listed below) at the following times:

- Saturday, November 2, 2024, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE FOLLOWING PARTISAN OFFICES: Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, US Senator, Representatives in Congress, Representative in State Legislature, Member of the State Board of Education, Regent of the University of Michigan, Trustee of Michigan State University, Governor of Wayne State University, Prosecutor, Sheriff, Clerk, Treasurer, Register of Deeds, Public Works Commissioner, County Commissioner, and the following Township offices: Supervisor, Clerk, Treasurer, Trustees, Park Commissioners.

ALSO TO ELECT THE FOLLOWING NON-PARTISAN OFFICES: Justice of the Supreme Court, Judge of Court of Appeals, Judge of Circuit Court, Judge of District Court, Judge of Probate Court, Delta College Board of Trustees, Township Library Boards, City Offices, Village Offices, Local School District Board Members, River Rapids District Library Board Members, and any other offices which may appear on the ballot at that time.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following proposals will appear on the ballot:

City of Saginaw Proposal 1 – Proposal to Amend the City Charter by Adding a New Chapter XIX, Section 1 Entitled, “Back the Blue Public Safety Priority”- Shall the Charter of the City of Saginaw, Michigan be amended by adding a new Chapter XIX, Section 1, to state that “The proposed Back the Blue Public Safety Priority City Charter Amendment, if adopted, would honor, better protect, and provide victim compensation for Fire and Police Officers, Emergency Medical Technicians and other First Responders, and their families.”

City of Zilwaukee Water Main Millage Renewal – Shall the City of Zilwaukee, Saginaw County, continue to levy three quarters of a mill (.75 cents per \$1,000.00 dollars) of taxable value of property located in the City of Zilwaukee, Saginaw County, for 5 years, (2025-2029) inclusive in accordance with Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution, which will collect in the first year of levy, an estimated revenue of forty thousand two hundred forty one dollars and forty cents (\$40,241.40)

Bridgeport-Spaulding Community School District Bond Proposal - Shall Bridgeport-Spaulding Community School District, Saginaw County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Twenty-Eight Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$28,400,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of: erecting, furnishing and equipping an addition to a school building; remodeling, including security improvements to, furnishing and refurbishing, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; erecting a community recreation building; and equipping, developing, and improving a playground, an athletic field and an athletic facility, driveways, parking areas, and sites? The following is for informational purposes only: The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2025 is 3.50 mills (\$3.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is thirty (30) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.90 mills (\$2.90 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$0. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$0. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances. (Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

Reese Unity District Library Millage Renewal Proposal - Shall the Reese Unity District Library, Counties of Saginaw and Tuscola, be authorized to levy a millage annually in an amount not to exceed .9965 mills (\$0.9965 per \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the millage rate that expires in 2024, against all taxable property within the Reese Unity District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2025 to 2034, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Reese Unity District Library will collect in the first year of levy (2025) if the millage is approved and levied by the District Library is approximately \$286,000.

All Saginaw County qualified electors have the right to mark a ballot and deposit the ballot in the County Early Vote Center tabulator beginning the second Saturday before an election and ending the Sunday before the election from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on the Wednesday prior to the election from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The Saginaw County Early Voting Center is located at 618 Cass St. Saginaw, MI 48602 and is open to all qualified electors within Saginaw County.
