Public Act 181 of 1953

An Act relative to investigations in certain instances of the causes of death within this state due to violence, negligence or other act or omission of a criminal nature or to protect public health; to provide for the taking of statements from injured persons under certain circumstances; to abolish the office of coroner and to create the office of county medical examiner in certain counties; to prescribe the powers and duties of county medical examiners; to prescribe penalties for violations of the provisions of this act; and to prescribe a referendum thereon. History: 1953, Act 181, Eff. Jan. 1, 1954; -- Am. 1969, Act 92, Imd. Eff. July 24, 1969
