The following is a list of changes to the bidding documents:

- 1. Addendum No. 2 has been posted to the SCPWC website by Friday, December 20, 2024.
- 2. The following clarification is being made in response to questions received from plan holders and follow-up coordination with the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR):
 - Work through DNR property is to take place from:
 - 1. June 1st to August 31st OR
 - 2. January 1st to March 15th.
 - ii. No burning is permitted on DNR property
 - iii. All trees and brush through **all** DNR property is to be windrowed at the edge of the work area.
 - 1. Contractor is responsible for placing windrowed trees in locations where they can be secured amongst standing trees on edge of work area, or placed in upland location on DNR Property within work area, without the risk of migrating downstream.
 - 2. On private parcels downstream of Teft Road, trees may be moved off of private property and windowed on DNR property.
 - Sheet 5 Station 41+90
 - i. If conditions do not allow for access to clear around the Pryor Drain to Wahl Road as specified on plans, contractor may be allowed to use trees as temporary ford crossing to cross Pryor Drain.
 - ii. In the space provided below, the contractor is required to enter an amount that will serve as a credit back to the project in the event that conditions do not allow access for clearing around the Pryor Drain to Wahl Road. A response below is required in order for the bid to be considered complete. The provided price below may be considered during the contract award process:

- SCPWC will offer the use of the county Bandit 2290 chipper at a rate of \$285/hour
 - i. Rate includes county operator
 - ii. Contractor is required to pay to mobilize the chipper to the Marsh Creek #2 Drain project, as well as from the Marsh Creek #2 Drain project to the next project location as directed by the SCPWC.
 - iii. The accrued cost for the use of the chipper will be deducted from the overall payment to the contractor.
- All access ramps constructed are to have a minimum drive width of 14 feet, and a minimum slope of 6 horizontal to 1 vertical.

Note all clarifications and changes contained within this Addendum supersede any data that may be contained in the plans and specifications regarding the same matter.
