2. Introduction
 - a. This meeting will entail general overview of project, construction schedule, specific items on plans and specifications, and questions and answers.
 - b. This is a mandatory Pre-bid Mtg. - Be sure to sign in; only those in attendance will be allowed to bid on the project.
 - c. Addendum No. 1 will be issued as a result of this Pre-Bid Meeting and will include the minutes of the meeting and sign in sheet, and be posted at:

 - d. Ask questions at any time.
3. Project Schedule
 - a. Bid Letting –
 - i. February 18th, 2020 @ 10:00 A.M. at the office Spicer Group.
 - ii. Bids will be received until 10:00 A.M.
 - iii. Bids will remain open to acceptance for 90 Days after the bid letting.
 - b. Notice to Proceed – Projected to be mid-May/June 2020.
 - c. Substantial Completion – September 15, 2020.
 - i. All pipe and structures installed, all roads paved, driveways repaired, and cleanup and site restoration completed.
 - d. Final Completion – October 15, 2020.
 - i. Any remaining site restoration.
 - ii. Vegetation established.
4. Construction Staking and Inspection
 - a. Staking – OWNER will provide through the ENGINEER all construction staking for the project.
 - b. Construction Inspection – All construction inspection for the project will be provided by the OWNER’S engineer.
5. Required Permits
 - a. MDOT – Obtained by Owner
 - b. Saginaw County Road Commission (No Charge) – ***Obtained by Contractor***
6. Utilities
 - a. As shown on the plans.
 - i. Consumers Gas Relocations
 - 8-inch S-MP gas main in the M-46 / Outer Drive intersection, preliminary schedule to relocate is March 2020.
 - The existing 8” gas along Outer Drive through the M-46 intersection, that will be abandoned, is in steel casing. Contactor will need to cut and remove steel casing and abandoned 8” steel gas main to install proposed 36-inch storm sewer. Cost to be included in the unit price bid per linear foot of storm sewer.

- 2" S-MP gas main along the west side of Prueter Drive will be relocated further to the west ***behind the power poles***, away from proposed storm sewer, and all services will be replaced. Preliminary schedule to relocate is March 2020. ***The main will be abandoned and left in place.***

ii. Consumers Electric

- Underground electric across M-46 near Sta. 2+90± will be de-energized by Consumers during construction and pipe will be installed under the cable if possible. Consumers will cut the cable out of the way if pipe cannot be installed under the cable. ***(This is a backup feed for Consumers)***

b. Project Coordination

- i. MDOT Project Number: 127021A/129594A, design build 2.4 miles of reconstruction and widening on I-75 from Hess Avenue to I-675 and reconstruction of the I-75/M-46 interchange and replacing structures at M-46 over I-75. ***(New bridge to be built, then switch traffic to new bridge and demolish old bridge)***

- ***Interchange complete 2020***
- ***Rest of I-75 work complete 2021***
- ***MDOT to attend progress meetings***
- ***MDOT coordination required April 1 – June 26***
- ***MDOT now required to test soil in road ditch for PFAS – 1 bore***
- ***MDOT replacing Outer Drive intersection***
- ***MDOT contract indicates that Prueter Drain work on I-75 be completed by June 26th.***
- ***Ryan M. (MDOT) Indicated that no plans are available yet for design build project.***

iii. Buena Vista Water Dept.

c. Bid Form

- Base bid is for concrete pipe and structures.
- Alternate bid items for HP and N-12 pipe and Nyloplast drain basins.
- Must fill out the entire bid form (base bid and both alternates) with total base bid and each alternate.
- Contract will be awarded based on the selected alternate.**

d. Bid Items

- All landscape grading and seeding will require a minimum of 4-inches of imported screened topsoil. **No re-use of existing topsoil from the site will be accepted.**
- Removal and disposal of existing pipe and structures is included in the unit price bid for the utility being installed.

- iii. Removal of any driveway pavements along Prueter Drive is included in the unit price bid for driveway repair.
- iv. Water Main Lowering's
 - All existing water mains are AC pipe.
 - All water main lowering's shall be ductile iron pipe, Class 52 with polywrap.
 - Includes: disinfection, (*swab pipe*) sampling and testing. (*visual inspection of joints and sampling port at one end of the lowering.*)
- v. Bentonite Clay Trench Barrier & Nitrile Gaskets
 - 50 Lb. bags of ENVIROPLUG MEDIUM or approved equal.
 - Review trench barrier detail. (Sta, 0+15 & 2+15)
 - Nitrile Gaskets from Sta. 0+00 to 2+32
 - ***Height of trench barrier to be a two to three bags overtop of pipe.***
- vi. Allowance – \$25,000 Contaminated Soil Testing and Tipping Fee
 - Allowance is for possible contaminated soils from Sta. 0+00 to 2+32. No payment from the allowance will be paid for trucking of soils. The Contractor will only be paid for authorized invoices for testing services and tipping fees. **No markups will be allowed.**
 - Any overages will be reimbursed by change order.
 - Any remainder of the allowance will **not** be paid to the Contractor.
 - ***Addendum No. 1 will contain a line item bid for “Non-Hazardous Contaminated Spoil Hauling”***
- vii. Traffic Control
 - M-46, all traffic control is itemized in unit price bid.
 - Prueter Drive – Lump sum
 - a. Maintain local traffic, mail, trash and emergency services.
- viii. Signals
 - Coordinate with MDOT

- e. Inspection Days
 - i. Engineer has estimated 30 Inspection days for M-46 work and 30 Inspection days for work on Prueter Drive.
 - ii. There is a line item for additional inspections days estimated by Contractor.
- f. Alternate bid items
 - i. Corporation, Saddle and Reconnect Existing Water Service (M-46), investigation and install only.

- 8. Questions:
 - a. ***Black Sand***
Black sand found in the pavement cores along M-46 is not anticipated to be contaminated. But if during construction the material needs to be tested, the testing will be covered by the Allowance for testing and tipping fees.

- b. Contaminated Soil Allowance (Brian Rohde)*
 - i. Brian requested that a separate bid time for hauling of contaminated spoils to a Type II landfill be added to the bid items. Dave V. indicated that he would add something to Addendum No. 1*
- c. Alt. #5 Bid Item:*
Investigate existing water service saddles on the 10-inch water main and replace saddle and corp and reconnect water service. Buena Vista will provide all materials necessary.
- d. Landscaped islands behind curb on south side of M-46:*
Contractor to move and stockpile existing landscaping material for installation of curb and gutter and replace after curb has been installed. Cost to be included in the unit price bid for “Curb and Gutter Remove and Replace” and “Cleanup and Site Restoration”
