

NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, May 6, 2025

To the Qualified Electors of the following school districts:

Birch Run Area School District, Montrose Community School District and Reese Public School District

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the Birch Run Area School District, Montrose Community School District and the Reese Public School District who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township Clerk; the Office of the appropriate County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Michigan residents with a valid Michigan driver's license or State ID can register online using the Michigan Online Voter Registration System at https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/ Registration forms can also be obtained at https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/ and mailed to the Township or Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/ and mailed to the Township or Clerk. The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is Monday, April 21, 2025.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at their respective Township Clerk's office (listed below) at the following times:

- Saturday, May 3, 2025, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, May 6, 2025, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following proposals will appear on the ballot:

I. Birch Run Area Schools Operating Millage Renewal Proposal - This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2025 tax levy. Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 18.5 mills (\$18.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Birch Run Area Schools, Saginaw and Genesee Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2026 to 2030, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2026 is approximately \$2,923,444 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2025 tax levy)?

II. Birch Run Area Schools Bond Proposal - Shall Birch Run Area Schools, Saginaw and Genesee Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Forty-One Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$41,260,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of: erecting, completing, remodeling, equipping and re-equipping school buildings, facilities, and additions to school buildings and facilities; furnishing and refurnishing school buildings and facilities; acquiring, installing, equipping and re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; and acquiring, preparing, developing, improving and equipping athletic fields, play fields, playgrounds, structures, facilities and sites? The following is for informational purposes only: The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2025 is 3.5 mills (\$3.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a 2.9 mills net increase over the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-five (25) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 4.58 mills (\$4.58 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). (Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

Montrose Community Schools Operating Millage Renewal Proposal - This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2025 tax levy. Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 17.3904 mills (\$17.3904 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Montrose Community Schools, Genesee and Saginaw Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2026 to 2035, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2026 is approximately \$861,647 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2025 tax levy)?

Reese Public Schools Sinking Fund Millage Proposal - Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Reese Public Schools, Tuscola, Saginaw and Bay Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1.5 mills (\$1.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2025 to 2029, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for and the construction or repair of school buildings; for school security improvements; for the acquisition or upgrading of technology; for the acquisition of student transportation vehicles; for the acquisition of parts, supplies, and equipment used for the maintenance of student transportation vehicles; for the acquisition of eligible trucks and vans used to carry parts, equipment, and personnel for or in the maintenance of school buildings; for the acquisition of parts, supplies, and equipment used to maintain such trucks and vans; and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2025 is approximately \$445,370?

All Saginaw County qualified electors of the Birch Run Area School District, Montrose Community School District and the Reese Public School District have the right to mark a ballot and deposit the ballot in the County Early Vote Center tabulator beginning the second Saturday before an election and ending the Sunday before the election from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on the Wednesday prior to the election from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The Saginaw County Early Voting Center is located at 618 Cass St. Saginaw, MI 48602 and is open to all qualified electors of the Birch Run Area School District, Montrose Community School District and the Reese Public School District.
