RE: OBSOLETE PROPERTY REHABILITATION EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE

Dear Commissioners:

The City Council of the City of Saginaw is a Qualified Local Government Unit eligible to approve Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Act (OPRA) Certificate transfers under Public Act 1246 of 2000, as amended.

On March 28, 2024, Hamilton Street Real Estate, LLC submitted an application for an OPRA certificate for 122 S. Hamilton Street. The application proposes a rehabilitation project with an estimated expenditure of \$1,700,00.00. Under the terms of this OPRA certificate and the City Council policy, Hamilton Street Real Estate, LLC could have a "tax freeze" for up to twelve (12) years. This abatement excludes existing taxes, the value of the land, and personal property resulting in potential abatement on property improvements. Taxes will be levied at the full rate following the expiration of the abatement.

State law requires notification to taxing units of the receipt of this application. The City Council will hold a public hearing on this application at the Monday, May 20, 2024, City Council meeting beginning at 6:30 p.m. in Council Chambers of City Hall.
