

NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2025

To the Qualified Electors of the following school districts: Birch Run Area School District and the Saginaw Township Community School District

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the Birch Run Area School District and the Saginaw Township Community School District who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township Clerk; the Office of the appropriate County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Michigan residents with a valid Michigan driver's license or State ID can register online using the Michigan Online Voter Registration System at https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/ Registration forms can also be obtained at https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/ and mailed to the Township or Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is Monday, Oct 20, 2025.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at their respective Township Clerk's office (listed below) at the following times:

- Regular business hours (times listed below)
- Saturday, November 1, 2025, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, November 4, 2025, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following proposals will appear on the ballot:

Birch Run Area Schools Bond Proposal - Shall Birch Run Area Schools, Saginaw and Genesee Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Seventeen Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$17,800,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of: remodeling school buildings and facilities, including upgraded skilled trades instructional space, roofing, boiler, heating, cooling and mechanical equipment replacement; erecting additions to school buildings and facilities, including additional classrooms; equipping, re-equipping, furnishing and refurnishing school buildings and facilities; acquiring, installing, equipping and re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; and acquiring, preparing, developing, improving and equipping athletic fields, play fields, playgrounds, structures, facilities and sites? The following is for informational purposes only: The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2026 is 1.15 mills (\$1.15 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a 0 mill net increase over the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty (20) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.25 mills (\$2.25 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). (Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

Saginaw Township Community Schools Bond Proposal - Shall Saginaw Township Community Schools, Saginaw County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed One Hundred Sixty-Nine Million Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$169,210,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of: erecting additions to, remodeling, including security improvements to, furnishing and refurnishing, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; erecting a school support building; acquiring and installing instructional technology and instructional technology equipment for school buildings; and developing and improving athletic fields and facilities, driveways, parking areas, and sites? The following is for informational purposes only: The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2026 is 3.95 mills (\$3.95 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-five (25) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 5.21 mills (\$5.21 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$9,705,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$0. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances. (Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

All Saginaw County qualified electors of the Birch Run Area School District and the Saginaw Township Community School District have the right to mark a ballot and deposit the ballot in the County Early Vote Center tabulator beginning the second Saturday before an election and ending the Sunday before the election from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on the Wednesday prior to the election from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The Saginaw County Early Voting Center is located at 618 Cass St. Saginaw, MI 48602 and is open to all qualified electors of the Birch Run Area School District and the Saginaw Township Community School District.
