HOW TO UPDATE YOUR ADDRESS

CIRCUIT COURT RECORDS

- 1. You must present your Michigan driver's license or a Michigan personal identification card. The new address does not need to match what is on the ID, but it must reflect an accurate current name and photo.
 - a. If you do not possess a Michigan ID, you may show any of the following forms of photo ID as long as it is current: Driver's license or personal ID card issued by another state, Federal, state, or local government-issued photo ID, U.S. passport, Military photo ID card, Student photo ID card from an educational institution, Tribal photo ID card.
- 2. You will need to complete a separate form for **EACH** case in which you are trying to change your address.
- 3. If your case involves the Friend of the Court, it is **YOUR** responsibility to inform them of any address changes. We use different systems, and we cannot update your address in the FOC system.
- 4. Finally, complete this form in its entirety. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
