10th Circuit Court Local Administrative Order 2024 –10
Rescinds Administrative Order 1993-3

FRIEND OF THE COURT MAKE-UP PARENTING TIME POLICY

This administrative order is issued in accordance with MCL 552.642, effective October 10, 2024.


IT IS ORDERED:

1. In all domestic relations cases in Saginaw County where a parenting time order has been entered, the make-up parenting time policy of this administrative order shall be applicable as provided by this order.
2. The Saginaw County Friend of the Court shall develop and make available at its office an approved form to use by a party to submit a complaint that parenting time has been wrongfully denied by the other party.
3. Said complaint shall be submitted to the Friend of the Court office within 56 days of the alleged denied parenting time.
4. Within 14 days of receipt of the complaint, Saginaw County Friend of the Court shall review the form to determine whether the form is fully completed correctly, the allegations in the request set forth a violation of the court order, and that the violation occurred within 56 days. If satisfied that all requirements are met, Friend of the Court must mail a copy of the complaint to the alleged violator and each party, along with a notice pursuant to MCL 552.642.
5. If a written response is not provided to the Friend of the Court within 21 days of when the notice was sent, then Friend of the Court shall notify the parties that the make-up parenting time policy below applies:
 - a. Makeup parenting time shall be the same type and duration of parenting time as the parenting time that was denied, including, but not limited to, weekend parenting time for weekend parenting time, holiday parenting time for holiday parenting time, weekday parenting time for weekday parenting time, and summer parenting time for summer parenting time.
 - b. Makeup parenting time shall be taken within 1 year after the wrongfully denied parenting time was to have occurred.
 - c. That the wrongfully denied parent shall choose the time of the makeup parenting

- time.
- d. The wrongfully denied parent shall notify both the office of the Friend of the Court and the other parent in writing not less than 1 week before making use of makeup weekend or weekday parenting time or not less than 28 days of making use of makeup holiday or summer parenting time.
